



## > National Recognition Policy

Chamber of Commerce & Industry Queensland (CCIQ) accepts and nationally recognises the decisions and outcomes of any other Registered Training Organisation (RTO), or body in partnership with an RTO, thereby ensuring the mutual acceptance throughout Australia of the qualifications and Statements of Attainments awarded by RTOs.

In accordance with the Australian Quality Training Framework, CCIQ understands that national recognition means the acceptance of the decisions of the registering body that has registered a training organisation, or the course accrediting body that has accredited a course, by another registering/course accrediting body, without there being any further requirement, including:

- > the recognition by each registering body of the decisions of registering bodies in other states and territories in relation to the registration of training organisations and the imposition of sanctions, including cancellation of registrations
- > the recognition by each course accrediting body of the decisions of course accrediting bodies in other states and territories in relation to the accreditation of courses.

CCIQ staff and contractors realise the recognition by all state and territory registering/course accrediting bodies of the national endorsement of training packages as notified on the National Training Information Service.

Furthermore, CCIQ recognises and accepts that Australian Qualification Framework qualifications and Statement of Attainment issued by other RTOs enables individuals to receive national recognition of their achievements.
